EXAMPLES OF CURRENT CASES

- In re Packaged Seafood Antitrust Litigation, MDL No. 2670, Southern District of California (representing national supermarket chains to recover from a cartel involving the three largest manufacturers of canned tuna in the United States).
- In re Generic Pharmaceuticals Antitrust Pricing Litigation, MDL No. 2724, Eastern District of Pennsylvania (representing national supermarket chains that own and operate pharmacies in an action against over 20 pharmaceutical companies for conspiring to increase prices of generic pharmaceutical drugs).
- In re Broiler Chicken Antitrust Litigation, 16-cv-8637, Northern District of Illinois (representing national supermarket chains in an action against poultry manufacturers for conspiring to reduce supply which increased the prices of chicken in the United States).
